RULES FOR DUMPSTER DISPOSAL

Please observe the following rules when using the residential and commercial dumpsters:

Construction and demolition materials

Depending on the type of materials, it can be hauled to the City of Plainview Landfill or the Baker Pit. For more information, please contact the Landfill at 296-1152.

Roofing materials and shingles

This type of material can be hauled to the City of Plainview Landfill.

Metal Items

These types of items can be disposed of at the City of Plainview Landfill or at the Plainview Recycling Center.

Grass, leaves, brush and tree limbs

Brush and Tree Limbs can be disposed of at the City of Plainview Landfill. If you have any questions, please contact the Landfill at 296-1152. Grass and Leaves can be disposed of at the Green Box locations (See Green Box Locations).

Large/Bulk Items

Items too large to allow the dumpster lids to close (including mattresses, uncut tree limbs, garage doors, large furniture, etc.) These types of items can be disposed of at the City of Plainview Landfill or you can try our Loan-a-Truck Program.

TWO LOCATIONS TO SERVE YOU

Landfill Services

The City of Plainview Landfill disposes of 30,000 tons per year of household and commercial waste. The landfill gives away mulch and firewood free of charge, and also recycles all oil, filters, and metal brought to the landfill.

Fees & Exemptions

City of Plainview residences who pay a City of Plainview water bill are exempt for items such as: furniture, appliances, brush, and yard waste.

For tires and remodeling materials (i.e., sheet rock, boards, roofing, carpet, etc.), the individual resident and/or business must pay the disposal fees.

Unaccepted Items

Items are not accepted if they are corrosive, explosive, pesticides, liquids, hazardous waste, or medical waste.

Tipping Fees

Secured load - \$41 / ton | Unsecured load - \$61.50 / ton

The tipping fees are prorated based upon the tonnage. The landfill accepts cash, check, and charge accounts.

Baker Pit Services

The Baker pit accepts inert materials only (This includes concrete, bricks, uncontaminated soil, rocks, etc.)

Pickup Truck (1/2 or 3/4 Ton), Two-Wheel Trailer - \$3.75 per trip
One-Ton Truck, Four-Wheel Trailer - \$5
Single-Axle Dump Truck - \$10
Tandem-Axle Dump Truck - \$20
Trailer Dump (Semi) - \$30

SERVICES AVAILABLE IN THE CITY

Plainview Recycling Center

Recyclables may be dropped off at the Plainview Recycling Center. This Center accepts all items described under Recyclable Materials.

Recycle Carts

The recycle cart service is free of charge to all local businesses and can be set up by calling the recycle center at (806) 291-1222. The recycle carts are picked up on Thursdays only. Each business with a full cart needs to call in before Thursday to be put on the pick-up list. Office paper, bagged shredded paper, and newspaper are the only items that can be put in the recycle carts.

What are Recyclable Materials?

Glass

All colors of glass bottles. Glass is not to be put in recycle bins. All glass items need to be brought to the recycling center.

Metal Cans

Aluminum cans (Coke cans)
Food containers (such as soup and tuna cans) (Remove labels and rinse)

Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard (All cardboard must be clean and wax free.)

Phonebooks

All Phonebooks must be brought to the recycling center.

Newsprint Items

Computer paper
Junk mail
Newspaper
Office paper
Shredded paper

Plastic

Containers #1 and #2
Juice bottles
Milk jugs
Soda bottles

E-Waste

Computers, Printers, and Televisions. All E-Waste items must be brought to the recycling center.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

Loan a Truck Program

The Loan a Truck Program is for City of Plainview residents only and is **free** of charge unless the resident loads any kind of remodeling materials or tires.

The City of Plainview will not pick up any bulk items left by the curb or around trash containers. It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of these items properly.

Please contact the Service Center at 296-1146 to reserve a truck today. Applications are also available on the City website.

Grass, Leaves, Brush and Tree Limb Services

The City of Plainview has several green box locations in the community. The green boxes are to be used for grass and leaves only. Do not drop off brush and tree limbs at these sites, please bring them to the landfill.

Green Box Site Locations:

- 2nd & Columbia
- 4th & Floydada
- W 16th Street Park

All brush and tree limbs can be disposed at the Landfill for free. The brush and tree limbs are turned into mulch and is available free of charge for anyone wanting to use it in their plants and/or gardens.



Help STOP Illegal Dumping in Plainview!

Illegal dumping is putting trash, garbage, waste, anything discarded where it doesn't belong, whether or not the person dumping owns the property.

When you call to report an illegal dumping activity, please provide the following information:

- Time and date of activity
- Description of the vehicle
- License plate number
- Location of activity
- Description of items dumped
