

LOAN-A-TUB

CITY OF PLAINVIEW BULK REFUSE, SELF-HELP PROGRAM

The City of Plainview may provide a resident or group of residents with the use of a LOAN-A-TUB on a first come-first serve basis. The City may provide, upon approval of the Landfill Superintendent, the use of City dump truck, LOAN-A-TUB, or roll off to a commercial establishment or property where the City has initiated Code Enforcement action. The following is a list of provisions that will be used to make this service available inside the City Limits only.

- 1. The LOAN-A-TUB must be placed within the boundaries of the requesting party's property, or in a street adjacent to said property. <u>Under no circumstances shall the LOAN-A-TUB be placed blocking an alley.</u>
- 2. This service is only provided for residential water customers in residential areas. The program's primary intended use is for removing bulk refuse items, including tree limbs, appliances, etc. and <u>excludes the use by commercial contractors and/or contractor's materials</u>. If used for removing construction/demolition type materials, you will be billed the current tipping fee for disposal of (e.g. lumber, sheetrock, shingles, carpet, concrete, bricks and shredded tires). Rates are set to change as updates occur periodically please confirm pricing by checking the Master Fee Schedule Section 13.06.066 prior to your reservation.
- 3. A city employee will be scheduled to deliver the LOAN-A-TUB on your delivery date and will remove the LOAN-A-TUB the following morning. Reservations made for the weekend will have delivery of the LOAN-A-TUB Friday with removal set for Monday morning.
- 4. When a group of residents request a LOAN-A-TUB, it will be the responsibility of the resident where the LOAN-A-TUB is placed to ensure debris will not be strewn and will ride properly upon removal from the loading site.
- 5. Any requesting party shall not be able to utilize the LOAN-A-TUB more than one time in any given week. This service is provided by the city to assist the citizenry in disposing of bulk refuse items, and to further enhance the efforts toward health and beautification of the city.
- 6. In the event of natural disaster or extreme weather events the city may have to cancel scheduled tubs.

(The Sanitation Superintendent may waive provisions of this policy if extenuating circumstances exist.)
