_____ I understand this commitment to a pet.

Note: pets can live up to 15-20 years. The average cost per year for an animal costs \$500-800 per year, which includes food, vaccinations, yearly vet visits for health checkup and more.

_____ I have received a copy of the current animal ordinances for the City of Plainview.

_____ I am aware that in the State of Texas (as of January 18, 2022) CHAINS are against the law (appropriate tethers are still acceptable).

_____ I understand that if the pet will spend the majority of time outside, I will provide adequate shelter (hard floor, 3 walls, and a roof), access to water at all times, and food.

_____ I understand that the pet cannot roam free as it pleases and can be picked up by animal control if it is out. I also understand that citations may be issued to me as an owner.

_____ I understand that if the pet is sick or injured, I am responsible to take it to the vet in a timely fashion, or in cases of emergency, as quickly as possible.

_____ I understand that the pet must be on a leash at all times (when walking or out of the yard area and unless at a dog park).

General Information

You must be 18 years of age to adopt from PAM.

A valid government ID is required to adopt an animal from PAM.

All pets adopted must be spayed or neutered and documentation from the vet must be provided once completed.

PAM has the right to refuse any application submitted to us. PAM also has the right to take the animal back if proper conditions are not met.

Dogs

Those adopting a dog and currently have a dog at home are required to host a meet and greet prior to adoption to ensure all animals get along.

PAM encourages the dog receive crate training.

PAM encourages adequate dog training newly adopted dogs.
